Confirmation:

What is it?

Confirmation refers to the series of classes and experiences that churches have traditionally offered to help students be prepared to affirm their faith in a service of the affirmation of baptism, typically done on reformation Sunday each fall.

Why?

When someone is baptized into the Lutheran Church, the community makes promises to that individual to care and pray for them and to teach the Lords Prayer and the ten Commandments, and to educate them in the faith and place the bible in their hands.

Expectations and Responsibilities:

- Four Sessions over up to 5 years: students in 7th grade or older may choose to participate in 6 week sessions offered twice a year in the fall and spring. Students are asked to participate in one new testament, one old testament, and two others sessions (or more if you like) before writing their faith statements and being confirmed.
- Acolyting and serving of meals during 7-8th grade years, 2 of each each year
- 10 Sermon notes during the months surrounding the sessions you're enrolled in
- Faith Statement Presented to the congregation
